

Training for Industry



On-Site Auditing

The STA provides independent and impartial training on a variety of topics related to emissions monitoring.

A requirement of the Environment Agency Operator Monitoring Assessment (OMA) scheme is for process operators to carry out periodic auditing of stack-emissions monitoring activities. On-site auditing ensures that the personnel carrying out stack emissions monitoring do so in accordance with the agreed site-specific protocol (SSP) and documented standards and procedures. The aim of this one day training course is to provide a basic understanding of stack emissions monitoring techniques, in order to enable process operators, regulators and environmental consultants to audit stack monitoring contractors.

Course content:

- ◆ MCERTS schemes for CEMS, personnel and organisations
- ◆ Pre-monitoring checks
- ◆ Equipment used in stack-emissions testing
- ◆ Auditing the stack-emission monitoring team
- ◆ Post monitoring checks

One day starting at 10.00 hrs.
